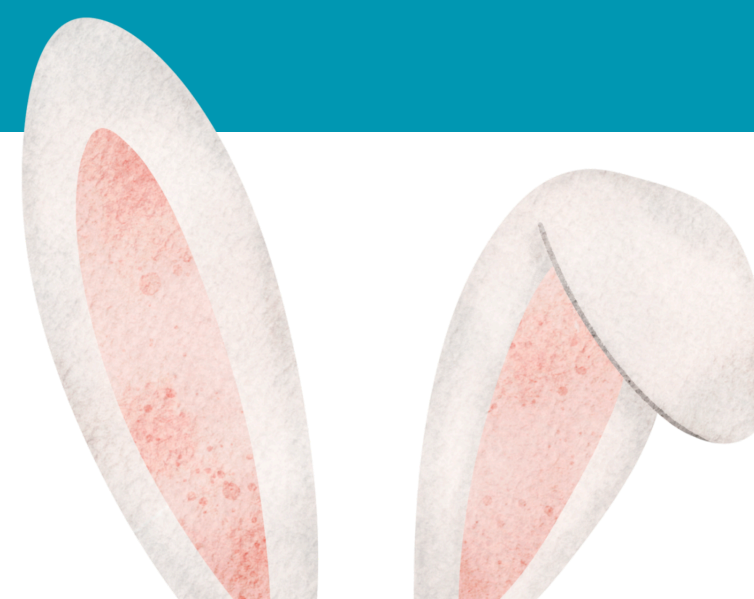

As colder weather approaches, here are practical tips to adapt and maintain performance:

- Cold conditions can reduce distance. When the ball and your body are cold, you may lose approximately 5–10 meters of distance.
- Cold air and slower muscle warm-up can further reduce distance, potentially adding another 10–15 meters of distance loss (totaling around 15–20 meters).
- Plan for extra club length in such conditions, and, when possible, perform warm-up shots to activate muscles and improve swing speed.
- Keeping muscles warm helps minimize distance loss and maintain feel and accuracy.
